

COLDWATER CITY COUNCIL  
SPECIAL MEETING  
Tuesday, February 14, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.

The governing body of the City of Coldwater met in special session for the purpose of discussing the front-end loader, with the following present: Mayor Penny Bruckner, Council members Renee Blasi, Mike Bushnell, Joe Ceballos and Jason Martin, Public Works Supervisor Danny Shaw, and City Clerk Kristal Sherman. Council member Daniel Hess was absent.

Mayor Bruckner called the special meeting to order.

Danny told the council he contacted Robin Roberts regarding the Liebherr loader he is offering to sell the City. He asked Robin if he would be willing to drop the price to \$133,000.00, he said he would, but it does not come with axillary hydraulics and a grapple bucket. He said he would add the hydraulics for \$5,000.00 and the grapple bucket for \$7,000.00. He also said Case Equipment will honor the \$133,000.00 price they had given him, and theirs does include the hydraulics and grapple bucket, they will also service it for the first 3,000 hours. Joe said they just spent \$7,000.00 on new tires on our loader last year and would like to see our loader fixed instead of spending \$133,000 for a new one. Danny said if they choose to repair the loader, he wants to have it hauled to Foley Equipment in Wichita, he has been talking with the mechanic there and feel they have better knowledge of the machine than the mechanics at Dodge City, he said if they have it hauled to Wichita, he could haul the roller up there at the same time and have it dropped off at Murphy Tractor in Park City. After the council discussed the loader situation, Joe made a motion to repair our current loader at \$30,000.00 max and also take the roller to have it repaired at the same time, seconded by Mike and the motion carried.

With no further business presented, Jason made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Renee and the motion carried.
