

COLDWATER CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING

Thursday, December 30, 2020 at 5:30 p.m.

The governing body of the City of Coldwater met in special session for the purpose of approving code enforcement resolutions and year-end bills, with the following present: Mayor Penny Bruckner, Council members Mike Bushnell, Robert Cardoza, Cleta Lampe and Ashta Rosson, and City Clerk Kristal Sherman. Council member Renee Blasi was absent.

Mayor Bruckner called the special meeting to order.

Mayor Bruckner presented Resolution No. 2020-6 which sets out orders regarding the property of Bernardo Salis-Lugo at 801 E. First St., giving 10 days to remedy the violations. Ashta made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2020-6, seconded by Robert and all voted Yes. Mayor Bruckner presented Resolution No. 2020-7 which sets out orders regarding the property of Teresa Brooks at 200 N. Washington, giving 10 days to remedy the violations. Ashta made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2020-7, seconded by Robert and all voted Yes.

Bills in the amount of \$68,262.25 were presented for payment. Cleta made a motion to pay the bills as presented, seconded by Ashta and all voted Yes.

Mayor Bruckner asked the council if they wanted to give employees extra time off tomorrow, New Year's Eve for the New Year's Holiday. After discussion, Mike made a motion to close City offices at noon tomorrow for the New Year's Holiday, seconded by Robert and all voted Yes.
